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# One Appointed Director Position From Shawnee Bend For Four Seasons Lakesites Property Owners Association, Inc. \_\_\_\_



**Qualifications:** Any candidate for a Director's position must be a member in good standing of the Association by;

- a. Being current on all financial obligations to the Association.
- b. Not being a party to any legal action in which the Association is in an adversarial position to the candidate.
- c. Signing "Fiduciary Duties and Code of Conduct" statements that the candidate understands the responsibility and authority of a Director and to identify any possible conflicts of interest.
- d. Appointed person for this Director position must be from the Porto Cima neighborhoods on Shawnee Bend.

Board Directors must be able to commit the time necessary to responsibly fulfill their commitment to the organization. This includes: board training, analyzing financial statements, preparing budgets, being able to attend monthly work sessions and monthly meetings, participating in special meetings and working as a liaison for one or more volunteer committees. There is also a substantial amount of time invested in reviewing documents, visiting and reviewing on-site situations, attending social events and being prepared to assist in any other capacity required.

# **Yard Waste Dumpsite Update**

In 2017, the POA entered a joint effort with the Developer, Four Seasons Lakesites, Inc., to utilize an area of undeveloped land off Horseshoe Bend Parkway to provide owners a place to dump typical yard waste materials. For the past five years, this opportunity has been very well received and has been utilized by many property owners; however, there has recently been a substantial increase in instances of abuse. The POA would like to remind everyone of a few simple rules regarding this limited-use facility.

- Grass clippings, leaves, small ornamental plants that have died, etc. are the only items that may be brought to the dumpsite. No tree roots, tree stumps, tree trunks, household waste, furniture, appliances, or other such items are acceptable.
- Commercial landscaping contractors are not allowed to dump in this area unless they are working for a specific property owner who has contacted Owners Services or Management in advance to advise who the contractor is and what they will be dumping.
- ❖ Typically, you may plan to bring your yard waste material to the facility on Mondays through Fridays, between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.; however, we ask that you please call the Owners Services Department at 573-434-0021 or the POA office at 573-552-8334 to make prior arrangements for dumping.
- Property owners, or their designated contractors, are <u>NOT</u> permitted to dump in the area without an Owners Services or Management representative present.
- During periods of precipitation, we will close the site to avoid vehicles getting stuck or creating ruts that others will have to navigate.
- Any individuals found entering or using the facility without an Owners Services or Management representative present will be considered trespassing and will be charged accordingly.
- ❖ The Owners Services Department will be vigil in their efforts to keep property owners and outside contractors from abusing this opportunity to avoid ruining this unique program for the benefit of all Four Seasons property owners.

Your Board of Directors and Management team would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation and your support of this very special program.

# **Yard Waste Disposal and Off-Season Hours**

Owners may contact the Owners' Services Department to pre-arrange a scheduled appointment for dumping yard waste. Starting **September 19th** the yard waste location is available as follows:

- Sunday-Saturday (<u>By Appointment Only</u>) Open from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Call Owner Services at 573-434-0021.

The following items will be accepted:

- Grass Clippings Dead shrubs & bushes
- Twigs, tree limbs & branches Leaves
- Old mulch Dead or dying flowers

The facility will not accept landscape rock, landscape cloth, steel or plastic edging or any inorganic materials that will not compost.



# **Fall Clean-Up: Leaves and Yard Waste**

As autumn approaches and leaves fall from trees, please remember you may dispose of leaves and other yard waste at Four Seasons POA. Simply call the Owner Services Department (573-434-0021) to make an appointment to open the area or take advantage of other approved means of disposal.

Ameren-MO does not allow leaves to be blown or dumped into the lake and does not allow burning leaves along the shoreline.

Horseshoe Bend Special Road District prefers that any leaves blown into

the roadside ditches are burned. When burning leaves in the ditches make certain the leaves are far enough away from the pavement to prevent damage.

Please remember to obtain a Burn Permit and check with your local fire protection district to ensure it is safe to burn the day you are burning leaves or other yard waste!

- Sunrise Beach Fire Protection District Burn Permits can be obtained on their website: http://sbfpd.org
- The Lake Ozark Fire Protection District provides an automated telephone system for Burn Permits at 573-365-6407.

Fires MUST be attended at ALL times and fully extinguished prior to leaving the burn site.

# Multi-Flo Systems Unique Service Requirements

In an effort to keep Four Seasons property owners informed, we would like to take this opportunity to advise owners who have Multi-Flo systems about their unique service requirements. Although the P.O.A. provides the pump-out of these systems approximately every three years, the pump-out is NOT automatically scheduled because the sock filters utilized in these systems need to be serviced at the same time. It is the owners' responsibility to have the sock filters serviced.

Since the pump-out and the sock filter service must be a coordinated effort we ask owners with a Multi-Flo system to please contact the Environmental Services Department at (573) 552-8334 to determine if it is time for your system to be serviced and to schedule the pump-out if necessary.

If you're not sure you have a Multi-Flo system or you have any questions about your wastewater treatment system and it's operation, please call the Environmental Services Department at (573) 552-8334.

## **Owner Services'**

Off-season hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., seven days a week.

The off-season coincides with the time when the heated swimming pools are closed which, in the case of this year, will start on **Monday, September 19th**.
